#### Survival Kit- Altoid can, suggested order for contents:

- 1. Attached in lid Waterproof matches with striking surface (in plastic bag) \*\* Matches are very fragile
- 2. Heavy duty foil packet (1) orig. 12" x 24" folded to fit use for cooking, capturing water
- 3. Reflective surface (1) cut from compact disc use for signaling
- 4. Razor blades (3) in plastic bag, use to cut small tree pieces for fire
- 5. Quart plastic bag (1) folded into small bag add approx. 1 quart of water + water purifier tablet
  Where to mark plastic bag for 1 quart of water?
- 6. Duct tape (1) one yard rolled, use to attach bandage or
- 7. Cotton balls (4) dipped in Vasoline use as tinder to start fire
- 8. Water purifier tablets (2) use with quart plastic bag read directions
- 9. In plastic bag: 14 yards fishing line (1) wrapped on cardboard

Bronze hook (1)

Brass swivel (1)

Lead sinker (1)

- 10. Green twine in plastic bag
- 11. To insure Altoid can will remain closed, enclose with rubber band.
- 12. To water proof Altoid can and contents, wrap outside edge with duct tape
